Hedge Fund Build Day To Be Held in Brooklyn

HEDGE FUNDS FOR HABITAT-NYC AND PRIVATE EQUITY LEADERS INVITED TO BUILD AFFORDABLE HOMES FOR LOW-INCOME HABITAT FAMILIES IN BROOKLYN

Brooklyn, NY — Hedge fund and private equity leaders are invited to trade their briefcases for tool belts on Friday, March 21, to help Habitat for Humanity – New York City build 41 affordable homes in Brooklyn.

The March 21 build will be from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. at NE corner of Atlantic Avenue and Eastern Parkway to the NW corner of Atlantic Avenue and Sherlock Place, Ocean Hill-Brownsville, Brooklyn.

Sponsored by Hedge Funds for Habitat-NYC, this event is limited to 35 volunteer-builders (no experience necessary). Volunteers are asked to donate a minimum of \$500 to Habitat-NYC to participate in the build, which will help cover construction costs.
