Hedge Funds for Habitat-UK team to compete in Habitat for Humanity's 2011 "Hope Challenge"

LONDON, UK (June 22, 2011) – LaCrosse Global Fund Services announced today that it is again joining the Hedge Funds for Habitat-UK team to compete in Habitat for Humanity's third annual Hope Challenge, which will take place July 1-3, 2011 in the Peak District. The event is part of a broad fundraising initiative to enable people living in poverty housing to access a safe, decent home in which to live.

LaCrosse will be part of the Hope Challenge event that involves teams of three to six people building their own shelter from scrap materials and spending two days and nights involved in various mental and physical challenges. Other scheduled activities include 20 kilometers of trekking and 1,000 meters of hill ascent.

In 2010, the event helped to build 56 Habitat houses in the developing world.
